Being Ready for School	Promote personal hygiene. Make sure that each child knows what is needed for the school day and wears appropriate clothing – encourage each child to leave school tidily	Send my child to school clean and neat and suitably dressed. Make sure my child has the things required for the school days e.g. pencil case, P.E. kit.	Keep myself neat and clean. Bring the things I need for my work to school and wear the correct clothes. Leave school tidily dressed.
Attendance and Punctuality	Promote attendance and punctuality at all times.	Make sure my child is present and punctual and inform school of all absence.	Come to school on time every day.
Schoolwork and Homework	Teach in an effective and purposeful way. Prepare each child in a range of subjects within the National Curriculum and for their future. Set meaningful work and mark it regularly.	Show an active interest in my child's work and support him/her. Encourage my child to do his/her best. Make sure my child does his/her best work at all times.	Listen to my teacher and work hard at all times. Make sure I know what the homework is before leaving school, do my homework neatly and return it on time.
Behaviour	Promote high standards of behaviour in line with the school rules. Treat people equally and with respect.	Encourage my child to develop high standards of behaviour at all times, and to treat people equally and with respect.	Behave well inside and outside school. Follow the school rules. Treat people equally and with respect.
Pastoral	Listen to, and respond to problems and worries immediately.	Try to attend parents' meetings. Read letters from school and respond to them when needed. Support the school and its rules.	Let my teacher, or any other adult know if I have any worries or problems as soon as possible.
Home/School	Hold regular parents' meetings/send home regular newsletters. Make you aware of any worries we have regarding your child.	Inform the school if there are any problems that are likely to affect my child's education.	To give all letters given to me at school to my parents and talk to my parents about the day's activities.
Extra-Curricular	Inform you of all events that are held in school or that the school is part of.	Try to support activities held by school, including P.T.A. functions.	Make the most of opportunities open to me at school e.g. sporting activities/concerts.
